

## M.O.S.E.S. GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING Tuesday, February 08, 2022 via Zoom video Conference



President Russell introduced the webinar presenters and the general procedures for use in this webinar.

President Russell called the 397th MOSES General Membership meeting to order at approximately 6:10 p.m. This is the 14th consecutive remote video conference. There were 135 members present.

President Russell appointed Jessica Leger as Sergeant at Arms and the facilitator for this meeting, and MOSES Attorney Catherine Costanzo as Parliamentarian.

The General Membership meeting minutes from the January 11, 2022 meeting were read. MOTION by to accept the meeting minutes that PASSED by electronic polling, 103 ACCEPT, 0 REJECT.

The Board of Directors minutes of the February 08, 2022 meeting were read and corrections were made.

The correspondence to and from MOSES was read.

The Treasurer's report for January 2022 was presented by Treasurer Galvin.

MOTION by to accept the January 2022 Treasurer's report that PASSED by electronic polling, 97ACCEPT, 1 REJECT.

MOSES Board member and former president Paul Donohue spoke to the membership on the benefits of naming a beneficiary on the MSRB Option D beneficiary form from the Massachusetts State Retirement Board.

The Commonwealth Collective Bargaining committee report was presented by Jessica Leger Co-Chair.

The MassDOT Collective Bargaining committee report was presented by Co-Chairs Allen Bondeson and Nick DelVento.

The MWRA Collective Bargaining committee report was presented by Chairman Pat Russell.

Overall there were many questions related to collective bargaining that were answered by the committee chairs.

President Russell gave the Administration report. Topics included the increase in the PFML rate, H&W forms availability, student loan forgiveness, DCR assets, Massachusetts Emergency Paid Sick Leave (MEPSL) funds availability for COVID related leave, and for members to call the Governor's office and move our pay raises forward.
