GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING
Tuesday, April 12, 2022
via Zoom video Conference

President Russell introduced the webinar presenters and the general procedures for use in this webinar.

President Russell called the 399th MOSES General Membership meeting to order at approximately 6:05 p.m. This is the 16th consecutive remote video conference. There were 129 members present.

President Russell appointed Jessica Leger as Sergeant at Arms and the facilitator for this meeting, and MOSES Attorney Catherine Costanzo as Parliamentarian.

The General Membership meeting minutes from the March 8, 2022 meeting were read. MOTION by [REDACTED] to accept the meeting minutes that PASSED by electronic polling, 70 ACCEPT, 0 REJECT.

The Board of Directors minutes of the April 12, 2022 meeting were read and corrections were made.

President Russell informed the membership of recent correspondence including a schedule of retro and bonus payments due to Commonwealth employees, and the status of hazard payments for public facing employees.

The Treasurer's report for March 2022 was presented by Treasurer Galvin. MOTION by [REDACTED] to accept the March 2022 Treasurer's report that PASSED by electronic polling, 101 ACCEPT, 0 REJECT.

The Commonwealth Collective Bargaining committee report was presented by Jessica Leger Co-Chair.

The MassDOT Collective Bargaining committee report was presented by Co-Chairs Allen Bondeson and Nick DeVento.

The MWRA Collective Bargaining committee report was presented by Chairman Pat Russell.

President Russell gave the Administration report which update the membership on a variety of topics including .

- noting the large, record setting monthly Commonwealth tax revenues
- the status of S1681 An Act related to timely retirement payment, <https://malegislature.gov/Bills/192/S1681>
- Members should take advantage of the public service student loan forgiveness program if eligible

-attending the annual NASHTU meeting in Washington gives MOSES the opportunity to discuss Transportation issues with legislators

-Recreation committee events; the May 20 Deep Sea fishing Trip, an Ecotarium event and a WooSox game planned for August

-in the future the Commonwealth plans to hire a third party vendor that will process all FMLA, PFML and employee sick leave requests.

NEW BUSINESS:

MOTION (20220412-4) by [REDACTED] to change Article X Section 1 Paragraph A of the MOSES Constitution by deleting the words: No more than two members shall be from the same department without prior approval of the board of directors, except for

Article X, Section 1, Paragraph A to read as follows;

Each committee shall consist of at least three members. The Collective Bargaining committees shall consist of at least seven members, a majority of whom shall be employees in the bargaining unit. The Budget committee shall consist of at least five members; one shall be the treasurer of this organization.

MOTION to adjourn by [REDACTED] that PASSED by electronic poll 61 ACCEPT, 3 REJECT
