President Russell provided the status of our pay raises under the recently ratified Commonwealth and MassDOT Collective Bargaining agreements.

The MassDOT Collective Bargaining committee report was presented by Co-Chairs Allen Bondeson and Nick DelVento.

The MWRA Collective Bargaining committee report was presented by Chairman Pat Russell.

There were many questions on collective bargaining that were answered by the committee chairs.

President Russell gave the Administration report. Topics included the availability of Massachusetts Emergency Paid Sick Leave (MEPSL), dealing with the Omicron variant,

isolation and quarantining protocols, PFML increases in benefits, and student loan forgiveness.
