GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING
Tuesday, March 08, 2022
via Zoom video Conference

President Russell introduced the webinar presenters and the general procedures for use in this webinar.

President Russell called the 398th MOSES General Membership meeting to order at approximately 6:05 p.m. This is the 15th consecutive remote video conference. There were 129 members present.

President Russell appointed Jessica Leger as Sergeant at Arms and the facilitator for this meeting, and MOSES Attorney Ryan Cross as Parliamentarian.

The Board of Directors minutes of the March 08, 2022 meeting were read and corrections were made.

The General Membership meeting minutes from the February 8, 2022 meeting were read. MOTION by [REDACTED] to accept the meeting minutes that PASSED by electronic polling, 102 ACCEPT, 0 REJECT.

The correspondence to and from MOSES was read.

The Treasurer's report for February 2022 was presented by Treasurer Galvin. MOTION by [REDACTED] to accept the February 2022 Treasurer's report that PASSED by electronic polling, 101 ACCEPT, 0 REJECT.

President Russell updated the membership on the status of the bill containing the pay raises for MOSES Commonwealth and MassDOT employees. In addition, the President provided the status of the COVID hazard pay and progress on determining who is eligible for hazard pay at each of the two levels, \$2,000 or \$1,000.

The Commonwealth Collective Bargaining committee report was presented by Jessica Leger Co-Chair.

The MassDOT Collective Bargaining committee report was presented by Co-Chairs Allen Bondeson and Nick DeVento.

The MWRA Collective Bargaining committee report was presented by Chairman Pat Russell.

There were many collective bargaining questions from the members and responses by the committee chairs.

President Russell gave the Administration report. Topics included the public service student loan forgiveness program, increases in the PFML usage rate, the sick leave cap in the governor's budget, Massachusetts Emergency Paid Sick Leave (MEPSL) funds availability for COVID related leave, MOSES representation at NASHTU, and third party administration of all employee leave requests, including sick leave.
